- No motorized vehicles or bikes on park trails.
- No Dog sledding on park trails.
- No boating on the park lakes, except for fishing in Heidecke Lake.
- No alcohol in the park.
- One responsible adult must accompany each group of 15 minors.
- Pets must be on leashes at all times.
- Be prepared for Mosquitoes and Ticks.
- Actions by nature can result in closed roads and other facilities. Please call ahead to the park office before you make your trip.
