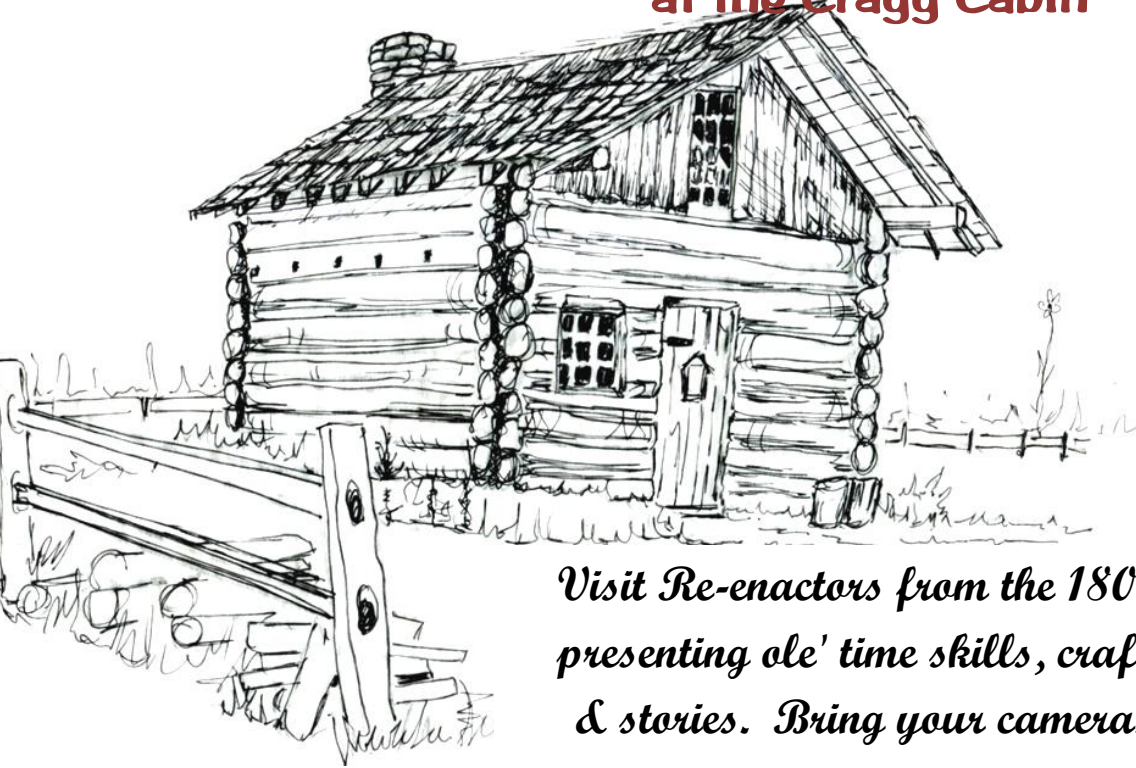

Driving Directions:

Take **Route 47** South of the Illinois River to Pine Bluff Road; go east about 5 1/2 miles to Jugtown Road.

Take **I-55**, South of the Kankakee River; take Lorenzo Road west 6 1/2 miles. Turn north on Jugtown Road.

Watch for Park Sign. Continue to the Visitor center after making a right at the stop sign.
