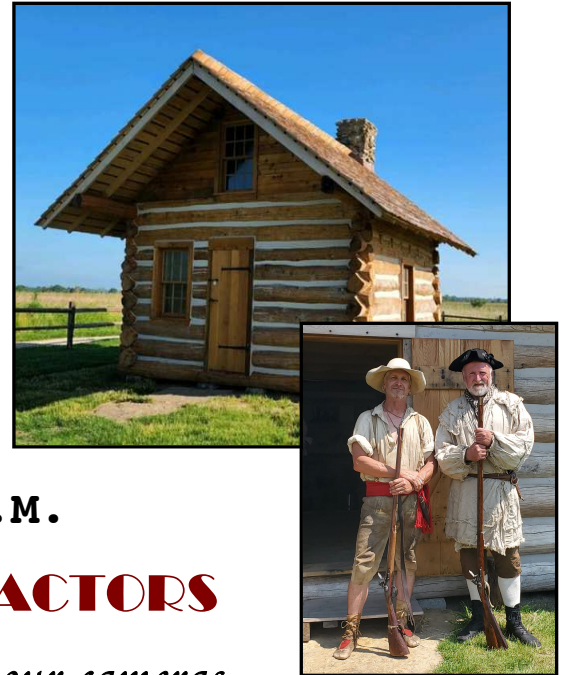
Park your car in the visitor center parking area. Walk the trail to the Cabin.
